Alumni Corporation Update

On January 16th, 2016 the Alumni Corporation Board held our quarterly meeting. The meeting was structured as a strategy session. The board performed an in-depth review of the financials and received an updated conditions report on the fraternity house. Several hours were spent discussing the fraternity house. The board prioritized the work needed to maintain the property and enhance it to attract future members.

Out of these discussions the board identified two critical streams of work. The first, are projects that require professional contractors. Those projects include installing a sprinkler system, per Illinois housing laws, installing a new boiler, replacing the roof and several others. These are long term projects to be completed over several years.

The second critical stream of work are those that can be accomplished by alumni. Primarily made up of smaller projects that can be completed in a weekend. The projects range from painting rooms and fixing floor tiles to simply clearing yard waste. The main time to complete these projects is during the annual summer work weekend. This year, the work weekend will be held July 8th – 10th 2016. Given the success of last year's work weekend we expect to accomplish a lot this year.

Currently, the house is operating below the breakeven point. This is primarily due to undergraduates leaving the university, not receiving dorm releases or otherwise deciding not to live in the fraternity house. This has moved the corporation into a negative cash flow. We are working with the undergraduates to improve the house numbers and hope to break even by the fall semester. Despite the current financial environment the corporation remains solvent with sufficient reserves.

The end of the calendar year was a little bumpy but a new year brings new energy. With the growing alumni involvement and a revamped recruiting strategy for the undergraduates 2016 looks to be a much improved year for Delta Upsilon.
